Entries: **Swim Coaches:* Please email your entries to Natatorium@kellerisd.net on or before **Sunday, February 10 at 8:00 pm**. A PDF entry report along with the MM .zip entry file must be submitted. The event file will be sent to SPC teams requesting it. Entries must be generated by HyTek Team Manager. Diving entries must also be included in the Team Manager entries. A confirmation email will be sent once entries are received and successfully loaded. An individual team psych sheet will be sent to confirm all entries and allow for corrections. Corrections must be received by Tuesday, February 12 at 5:00pm. A meet psych sheet will be sent to all entered teams Wednesday, February 13 by 10pm. Any entry questions should be directed to Robin Magan robin.magan@kellerisd.net

Diving Coaches:* Dive sheets must be entered on www.cleanentries.com on or before **Sunday, February 10 at 8:00pm. Diving athletes will perform eleven (11) dives, five (5) voluntary (maximum d.d. 9.0) and six (6) optional. Dive sheets are due at the same times swimming and diving entries are due. Dive sheet changes and/or corrections are due to the check-in table, no later than 2:00pm, Saturday, February 16. Divers must earn minimum of 190 points to score per SPC Rules. Entry Limit: Teams are limited to a maximum of **4 swimmers/divers** in an individual event and **1 relay team** per relay event. NHSF & UIL rules apply. **All participants including relay only participants** must be listed on the printed entry list and the HyTek entry zip file to be considered eligible to compete. Relay cards will be available in each team’s welcome packet to select relay swimmers. Relay athletes must be selected from athletes submitted in the entry list. All entries must meet the time standards published in the SPC Manual.

The shallow end and lanes 1-12 outside of the bulkhead will remain open at all times during the swimming competition for general warm-up. **NO DIVING IN SHALLOW END!**

Scoring: Individual events; 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1; Relay events - 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

Awards: Awards will be presented at the following designated times:

- Awards break after 200 Medley Relays
- Awards break after 50 Free
- Awards break after 500 Free
- Awards break after 100 Breast
- Awards break after 400 Free Relay

Medals will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each event. Trophies will be awarded to the girls' team champion and the boys' team champion.

Finalists are required to dress in warm-ups or in some type of team apparel when on the awards stand. The coach of the 1st place swimmer in that event or relay will hand out the awards for that event. Please note that awards will not be mailed after the conclusion of the meet.

Rules: National Federation Rules shall govern the meet, along with University Interscholastic League Rules and Regulations.

Timing: Lane timers/runners must be provided by the attending teams. Responsibilities will be assigned by conference representative and communicated to the meet director. Lane timers/runners meeting will be held 30min prior to the start of the meet.

Diving: Please email the name(s) of your diving judges to the meet director, by Sunday, February 10. Diving judges need to report to the diving referee thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the diving competition.

General Information

*Overflow parking, with a shuttle, will be available at the KISD stadium East side. All buses must be parked there.
